

Instructions for Writing a Doctoral Thesis Proposal

The proposal should be submitted in written form (.doc), it should be 2,500-4,000 words long and apply the following format:

A. Front page

Temporary Title - Candidate Name - Academic Year - Faculty/School

B. Contents

- 1. Introduction (short presentation of a topic in abstract form). The introduction should include a justification for the choice of topic and the basic theoretical and methodological framework. Finally, it should briefly present the originality of the proposed doctoral dissertation. (1-2 pages)
- 2. Research Question / Hypothesis. Separation of basic queries from secondary queries. (1-2 pages)
- 3. Presentation of main theoretical terms and how they will be used. Methodology. (1-2 pages)
- 4. Overview of existing literature / research activity on the subject. What will the proposed dissertation add to the specific scientific field? What is its originality? (1-2 pages)
- 5. Timetable (1 page)
- 6. Bibliography (1-2 pages)
